CREDENTIALS

Pro-Worker Registration will be conducted in the CFR Building at our Sebring Compound.

In order to receive Event Credentials, <u>you must first apply</u> online at <u>www.cfrscca.org</u> under 'Pro Racing', and - 1. Be listed on your Chief of Specialty's official roster. 2. Present an up to date SCCA Membership Card and Specialty License. There are NO EXCEPTIONS to these policies. The Official Event Credential will be the CFR 'RACE CONTROL' HARD CARD. If you have one, bring it with you. If not, they can be issued at the event.

Special Notes

If you arrive outside Official Registration Hours, are listed by your Chief and have your SCCA Cards on hand, you may call 727-452-6833 and request "Hardship Registration". Note that this service is not available later than 8:00 PM, and will not be available after 8:00 AM on Saturday. When you make this call, be prepared to leave a message and a call back number. This service is not intended as a substitute for Official Registration Hours.

Shuttles

Movement around the circuit will be by Shuttle vehicles, which will operate from the CFR Compound. Pickups can be arranged on CFR Radio TAC 2 from any corner station. Worker camping will be in the compound as directed by our paddock marshal. Parking will be provided adjacent to the CFR Compound. Details at Registration.
