# **SCCA Racing Stories...**

**Bob & Beau Borders** 

Some of the greatest racing stories ever told revolve around that of the classic tale of a father-son team. Bob Borders and his son Beau are no exception. Having both been crowned champions in their respective series this season, they both look back to reflect on their shared experiences racing in the SCCA.

Bob Borders began his racing career long before his son was born, racing flat track motorcycles and dragsters in the 1960's. In the mid 1970's he switched to Formula Fords, and has competed in various classes within the SCCA ever since. Beau was born in 1976, and attended his first race well before he could walk. As Beau graduated from diapers to big-wheels, Bob graduated from Formula Fords to GT-1 cars. Throughout his early youth Beau spent every day playing in his father's garage, and every other weekend reeking havoc at the race track while his father was clicking off laps. It didn't take long before Beau took an interest in the cars and began wrenching along side his father. By the time Beau was a teenager, Bob had upped his game in SCCA and also began competing in the 24 Hours of Daytona and the 12 Hours of Sebring. He had since moved the family down to Florida, where he could race 12 months out of the year. Before Beau ever attended Junior High School, he had already hopped over the wall for tire changes in the famed Daytona and Sebring endurance races. Being underage, he had to master the art of sneaking past the security guards so he could participate in his father's endeavors.

Beau always had intentions of getting behind the wheel, but those plans were delayed when he decided to move west and pursue a film career in California. Starting as in intern for George Lucas's famed Skywalker Ranch, Beau has spent the past fifteen years honing his craft of Sound Mixing and collaborating on such films as "Titanic", "Lord of the Rings", and more recently, "The Muppets". Of course, the racing bug never really left him. He attended Skip Barber Racing School at Laguna Seca at the age of 20, and spent the next few years scavenging budget conscious deals to run everything from Spec Racer Fords to IT cars and anything else he could get his hands on.


Bob and Beau reunited their racing careers in 2004 when, with the help of Leon DePestel, they constructed


a Mazda GT-1 monster to run along side Bob's Oldsmobile GT-1 machine. They ran together for two seasons, when Beau decided to switch to the ultracompetetive Formula Mazda series. Since then the duo has competed regularly in the Central Florida Region of SCCA. Even though Beau resided in California, he still chose to make the trek all the way to Florida to race near his father. The 2011 season was successful for both drivers with Bob scoring multiple wins and ultimately the GT1 Championship. Beau competed in the Formula Car Challenge, a Pro Series for Formula Mazda's that runs within the SCCA. He missed winning the championship by a mere few points due to his hectic work schedule, but made up for it by becoming this year's ARRC Champion - walking away with the win and a new track record.

Beau and Bob look forward to competing together in the SCCA and beyond. In addition to their solid foundation in both the GT1 and Formula Mazda categories, they are looking to explore another shared car that they can co-drive in endurance races - because as Beau has said time and time again, "nothing is cooler than racing with your old man!!".




