





There was a report on the response of visitors to our membership booth at both the Sebring 12 hour, and SPGP events. The booth at the recent St Pete event was in a very good location for spectator traffic. Ideas were brought up about other types of events outside of CFR participation, that a CFR membership booth may be worth consideration.

<u>District Three</u> held their April meeting at Rossi's Pizza on S. Orange Blossom Trail in Orlando with a mixture of Official, Racer, Solo/PDX and RallyX interests represented.

Governor Bill Martin thanked Lt. Governor Paul McLester for chairing the March meeting. Reporting on the Sebring 12 Hour, our 212 workers came from international locations (Netherlands, Germany, and Canada) as well as from the U.S. as far as Oregon and throughout Florida to manage the four days of racing. The parking situation was resolved by the start of our

registration and our campground was packed to its limit. Immediately following Sebring, we staffed the St. Pete race with World Challenge, Indy Cars and a Ferrari Challenge race thrown in for good measure. If you watched the delayed broadcast for World Challenge, you saw one of our own workers put out a car fire before any track responders arrived on scene. A great representation of our well-trained staff - Way to Go!

By the time you read this, we will have held our April Driver's School/PDX at Daytona. At this printing, there were 35 registered for the school and 80 for the Sat.-Sun. PDX.

We are working on staff for the 14 Hour ChumpCar event May 27 (Memorial Day weekend) at Daytona. Dennis Joyce is the contact.

Chuck Lutz - Solo Chair. reported that they had a good event at Stark (ERS). This was a joint event with Buccaneer Region and there were over 85 entries. The April 1st event at Geneva had 65 cars. On April 22, Solo will hold an event at Deland and they will also have events May and September at Daytona in conjunction with our races.

Doug McCabe - RallyX Chair. reported that they will be at Stark (ERS) for a two day event (run as a single event each day) in April and already have entries towing from long distances to participate. Memorial Day weekend will see a two day Divisional event again at Stark. Doug is also talking with East Bay on the west coast about events on their clay track.

Governor Bill reminded everyone that the June party has been reinstated and will be at our traditional site - the pool at the Kenilworth Lodge.





Flag Ravings

From Behind the Wheel, "From the standing start", the racing was wild and incident-filled in the World Challenge GT race double header events. Randy Pobst's Volvo all-wheel drive was an advantage at the start, however a 'ghost' in the machine caused his electronic system to shut down. When it pitted, the team determined that it wasn't safe to continue the race due to the electronics issue. His teammate Alex Figge led most of the first race but lost the lead when another car swerved into his path. Randy commented 'Just hold your line people!' In the second race, after replacing all the electronics in the car overnight, the 'ghost' returned causing Randy's car to once again shut off and the car was retired from the race.

Note: Randy started his racing career as an ITC driver in our CFR Region. Known to many of us, he's a strong supporter of Workers where ever he races.

And... From Behind the Barrier ... or in front of it if need be, when the intrepid Workers had to respond: To accommodate an extra support race group that paid the promoter to race in the St Pete 'canyon,' the weekend had to be expanded to include sessions on Thursday. The Workers who were able to staff the Thursday sessions on such short notice were much appreciated.

Officials from the World Challenge were present at one of the early morning meetings. The folks from World Challenge filled the Workers in ... again to emphasize the 50 car field, starting from a standing start was going to be a challenge in itself. Next up were the Indy Car folks who went over their guidelines. In addition, their safety director, Mike Yates gave Workers an overview of their new cars, where you could expect a fire, and where and how to attack it.

On Saturday, during the World Challenge race, a car pulled into the cut at Turn One and burst into flames. The driver bailed out, forgetting to shut off the switches. Workers Bill Stanton, Tom Sterritt and Jim Hooker grab fire bottles and respond ... keeping in mind there is oil and fuel feeding the fire. Eventually a crew member was able to shut off the master switch, while the EV crew and Firemen watched. Two dry chemical fire bottles and half of a water/cold fire extinguisher were needed to put out the fire.

According to our Chief, Jim, we can learn from this...

DRIVERS: when you pull off course and exit the car ... switches off - All of them!

WORKERS: when you respond, turn off the Master Switch if you can get to it safely - and watch for

oncoming traffic.

ALSO when you work a Pro Series event, the Master Cutoff Switch is not always located on the outside of the car and is not always in the same location inside either.

In Sunday's Indy Car Race, Tony Kanan paid an unscheduled visit to Turn 3 and stopped. The Safety Team pushed it behind the wall 'til the end. Meanwhile Tony had crossed the track, scaled fences and walked back to his pit.

My thanks to Randy's spokesman and to Jim Hooker who supplied the information about the event.

Also a big Thank You from the Flag Chief to all the Workers who worked long hours with few breaks for four days, CFR Workers all did their usual great , professional job.

TAKE ADVANTAGE: Be sure you've registered all the days you've worked on the main SCCA site ... and when you get your renewal forms, be sure you get your Worker discount. Sometimes they don't show up on the renewal statements, so a call to SCCA National to determine the correct amount to send would be advisable. Calls to that office are answered pretty promptly and courteously.

NOTE: don't feel ignored ... I figured I was the ugly little red headed stepchild when I saw the statement come through for Jerry. It said 'family membership,' listed his discount but ignored me. I figured I'd get my renewal forms in the mail, but no joy. It seems they just send out the form for the primary head of household... but there is no place to indicate who the 'family' includes. When I inquired, they had all the correct information combined and that my hard card and credentials would be included with Jerry's. They also said that they were trying to get the form changed to allow for putting family members' names to be included. Got the final total... with a healthy discount (it's my gimme' my discount time) so we're good to go. If you want the Yearly Waiver, you'll have to send in the waiver form and have it notarized either by the Registrar or your bank will generally notarize it for free. Don't know why, but CFR makes you sign the event wavers at all our races, but Florida Region accepts the yearly waiver.

Looking forward to the Drivers' School / PDX and the Regional / Enduro race at Daytona May 5-6 ... mark your calendars!




