





Flag Ravings

TIMING: Column deadlines and the April Event did not mesh. Though some of this might be old news, the April Drivers' School event was... well, eventful. Here's some insider insight.

DAYTONA APRIL DRIVERS' SCHOOL ...

the fast and the furious: With 35 School Drivers and a total of 80 PDX participants, good driving was shown by all. A radar gun was used by the Pit folks and we saw a car clocked at 111 mph on the infield School Course. The School group included a FISKAR, perhaps the first time an electric car has had track time ... and even a Maserati was entered. Very few incidents occurred, and I hope all the participants enjoyed their driving experience as much as we did watching them.

Random thoughts: Corner Workers - you did your usual flag large-excellent work. One thing to be suggested.... use lots of blue flags and also debris flags even for "minor stuff" on the track. This gets students used to seeing and heeding those flags too.

Instructors - Watch your speed on the Track Tour sessions. There were a couple of instances where Instructors hit 90 mph. To avoid panic for your students, and a chat with the Stewards, a maximum speed of 75 mph is recommended even when being passed by another instructor! Also watch for and correct any arms on the window sill by you and your students.

<u>Students</u> - Excellent Fire Drill response. This could be a lifesaver. *Note to Students* in the July School in Sebring, this is something you **CAN** try at home. Put on your *Nomex Drivers'* Suit, Gloves, Shoes, Helmet and Hans Device, get in your car, window net up and fully buckled in. At the School you have to exit your car within 30 seconds. Be advised your fire suit and helmet only provide about 18 seconds in a race car fire. The closer you can come to this, the safer you'll be.

And then there's the ever popular, Follow the Pace / Safety Car drill. Rule is, if the car has its lights ON, follow it wherever it leads you. If the Safety Car lights are OFF, when the Safety Car enters the pits and the double yellow flags are withdrawn, it's BOGGITY, BOGGITY, lets go racing time.

And finally, there's the ever popular "Ducklings" behind the Emergency Vehicle under a White Flag. You were all bunched up, dutifully following the EV until some sharp driver realized that you CAN pass the EV under a White Flag. At that point, all the rest of the field got the message and passed too.

New Students and all Drivers: - Next, do yourself and Timing & Scoring a favor, after you get your car ready for the track, make sure all the required stickers and class designations are on and clearly displayed. Then, stand back about 100 yards and see if the numbers and designations can be easily read. Check the colors to be sure the number stands out. Dark background, light number... light background, dark number. The darker the car is, the lighter the number should be (example blue numbers on black are hard to read and yellow numbers on white can also be difficult to make out.) No one in the Tower is getting any younger, and larger numbers are much appreciated.

Notable Quotes of the weekend: "I ignored the Checker at the Black Flag Station during a practice ... I didn't think it counted anywhere except Start." No, if you see a Checker at the Black Flag Station, acknowledge it and pull into the pits - do not take an additional lap. The Black Flag Station only shows the Checker during practice sessions ... it does not show the Checker during Qualifying sessions or during the Race. If you see a Checker there, go to the Pits, do not pass go, rather than collecting \$200, it will get you a chat with the Stewards.

We are most grateful for the memorial decals designed and produced through the efforts of Mark Dana, Miki Moerwald, and Mrs. Hulse ... to the Stewards for allowing Jerry and our Son, Scott, both CFR Drivers, to make a solo lap on the track, and a personal thanks to all my fellow Corner Workers for their LeMans flag salutes as well as to all the fellow drivers and families in the grandstands. It was a thoughtful memorial, a closure for our family, and a fitting conclusion to Mark's racing years.



CFR 35 Years Ago

Our Regional officials included some folks who are still active - Bill Martin (RE & Tech Chief), Van McDonald (Asst. RE & Chief Driver Instructor), Fran Martin (Sec), Bill Cannons (Dist 7 Gov & Pits Chief), and Charlie Hollis (Dist 8 Gov).

The CFR calendar had three regional events, two Regional/National events and two driver schools - in addition to supporting the pro events at Daytona and Sebring. Our race tracks were Daytona and Gainesville. The Gainesville track consisted of the drag strip, the return road (almost wide enough for two FV's) which connected to a parking lot outlined with cones and 55 gallon drum barrels (filled with water!) - then back onto the drag strip. Not a favorite of the drivers, a good turnout weekend was over 50 cars - but the entry fee was only \$50.

Our timing and scoring was conducted from a old non air conditioned school bus. We did much better at Daytona, particularly the Daytona Classic (Regional/National in August) where 250 entries was the norm and included notable drivers such as Paul Newman and Jim Fitzgerald.

The region membership was less than 500 - and our bank account balance often not much more than that. The SCCA was often referred to as the secret car club of America. While the annual dues were only \$25, the membership application required the signature of another SCCA member as a sponsor and the approval of your region's RE or the membership chair.

CFR did more than race, with an active rally program. We annually hosted the "Orange Blossom Special" Divisional Rally every March in the Ocoee area. Our newsletter (it was a newsletter, printed on newspaper) was appropriately called the "Checkpoint" - didn't become the "Checker" until 1978.


