SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Sanction No. 11-R-1568-S

This event is held under the 2011 General Competition Rules, based on the 2010 GCR and Category Specifications, as amended for 2011 per "FASTTRACK" and SEDIV/CFR Rules changes as published on the appropriate websites.

REGISTRATION: Drivers can register for the race online at www.DLBRacing.com. Drivers without internet access must complete a paper entry form and mail with entry fees to the pre-event registrar, **Deanna Harry, PO Box 247, Sebring, FL 33871**. Make checks payable to **Central Florida Region, SCCA**. *Second driver must submit separate entry form and \$35 fee.* Second drivers added, or changed, at the track, will be assessed a late fee. A \$25 fee will be charged for any check returned by the bank. A full refund will be made if the entry is withdrawn prior to Tech or, if a no show, your credit card payment will be refunded or your check will be destroyed. If you do not go to Tech, you must notify the Chief of Registration, **BEFORE YOU LEAVE THE TRACK**, in order to receive your refund. Phone/fax entries will not be accepted. Registration will be held in the CFR building located to the right of the main entrance to the raceway. Do not mail entries by any method that requires a signature upon delivery.

ENTRY FEE PAYMENT: Drivers who complete their registration online, via the DLBRacing.com website, will have the option of paying by check/money order, or by credit card at the time of registration. Entry fee payments for online registrants not received by the pre-event registrar by 7 days prior to the start of competition, may result in the cancellation of your entry, or the assessment of late fees. Credit Card payment option is available only for those drivers/entrants who complete their registration online, via the DLBRacing.com website. Credit cards will not be accepted for drivers submitting paper entries, or for entries received at the track.

PROBLEM ENTRIES: You are considered a problem entry if you did not register for the event prior to the close of online registration. You are also considered a problem if you do not have your license/membership, have to change drivers, change numbers, make payment, or do anything other than show your license, make crew changes and sign.

PASSES: Each entry receives four (4) pit passes, INCLUDING THE DRIVER AND ENTRANT. Additional passes may be purchased at Registration for \$5 each. Guests of the region may purchase their VIP pass at the membership window for \$5. VIPs are not allowed in hot areas. Workers, guests, & crew (all participants) must sign for their own passes and must arrive while registration is open. Workers and members are limited to one guest each. Worker license and membership card must be presented at registration.

DRIVER ELIGIBILITY: All drivers must be a member of the SCCA. A current SCCA National, SCCA Regional license, FIA Grades A, B, or C, or a valid SCCA Novice Permit is required to participate in this event. If you do not have the proper credentials it is your responsibility to contact the Registrar prior to the event.

CAR ELIGIBILITY: Competition is open to all cars conforming to the GCR, as amended. IT7, GTA, CF, SPO, SPU will compete under the current SEDiv approved rules. ALL CARS ARE REQUIRED TO USE AMB TRANSPONDERS. A limited quantity of transponders will be available for rent. Spec Miata tires will be as specified in the 2011 GCR.

VINTAGE: Cars must comply with Central Florida Region vintage competition rules. Drivers must comply with vintage participant conduct guidelines. Drivers must have a valid SCCA membership and SCCA vintage license or one of the licenses listed above.

COMPETITION NUMBERS: SEDiv permanent numbers will receive priority assignment when possible, depending on class groups, for entries received by May 25, 2011.

TIMING & SCORING: Driver/car number changes must be made prior to the start of the first race each day and must be coordinated through registration. Driver changes at the track will be assessed a \$50 late fee unless waived by the Race Board Chairman.

PACE/SAFETY CAR: In addition to GCR 6.6.2. The field shall follow the PACE / SAFETY CAR as long as its emergency lights are flashing, even if it varies from the normal race course.

QUALIFYING /GRID POSITIONS: Cars will be gridded for races 1-8 based on the fastest time recorded during the Saturday qualifying session. Cars will be gridded for races 9-16 based on the overall finishing positions for races 1-8. Cars will be gridded in this fashion regardless of who the driver was in the previous session. If a car does not compete in its respective preceding race, so as to earn a new starting position in the subsequent race, it shall start from the back of the grid.

TECH: All drivers must required equipment as required by the GCR, logbook and completed tech card to TECH.

SCALES: Will be available at Tech Saturday 10:00 am – 2:00 pm., or at other times at the discretion of the Chief of Tech.

RADIO FREQUENCIES: Frequencies: 464.525, 464.975, 464.675, 464.825 and 461.200 are guarded, and not to be used by any competitor/visitor.

PIT LANE: Pit lane speed shall not exceed 40 mph. Violators may be penalized.

CLOTHING: Closed toed shoes are required on the grid and over the wall on pit lane. Crew members on pit lane must display their event credentials at all times while on pit lane.**SOUND CONTROL:** Sound readings will be posted near T&S.

INSURANCE: Participant insurance will be provided in at least the minimum amounts required by the SCCA.

RESULTS: Qualifying, provisional and final results will be posted at the Timing and Scoring building. Drivers may obtain a copy of the final results from T&S. If results are not final before the track facility closes on Sunday, results will be mailed to competitors of those groups for which final results were not available. Additionally, final results will be posted to the CFR website, www.cfrscca.org, no later than 7 days following the completion of the event.

COURSE: Sebring International Raceway is a 1.7 mile road course. The Club Course. Absolutely no unauthorized access to the course will be permitted after hours or at any time.

PROVISIONS: Camping is allowed in the paddock on Friday and Saturday nights. Water and electricity are available in limited areas of the paddock. A \$20 charge will be assessed to all those parking in areas with 20 amp electric access, a \$30 charge will be assessed to all those parking in areas with 30 am electric service. The charges applies even if you do not utilize this service. Fuel will be available at the track. Tire vendors typically in attendance are: APPALACHIAN RACE TIRES (865) 681-6622, Competition Tire South (Goodyear) 386-274-5332. Safety Equipment and racing products: Trackside Tim's 800-247-4260, Speed Com Communications 813-842-8093. Do not leave used tires at the track.

PADDOCK PARKING: Do not set up trucks, trailers and motor homes parallel to main infield roads. Do not park in spots with electrical provisions unless you hook up. Failure to follow the direction of the CFR paddock marshal, or other CFR official, may result in denial of the driver's ability to compete at this event.

TROPHY: Trophies will be awarded to first place class finishers for races 2 through 8, and in accordance with the GCR for races 10 through 16. Location of trophy distribution will be announced. Trophies may be distributed even if final results are not available.

EMERGENCY CALLS: CFR has an emergency number at the track (863) 655-3033. In case of emergency and you cannot reach this number, call the Highlands County Sheriff Office at (863) 385-5111. Inform the Sheriff's office that the party you need to get in touch with is at Sebring International Raceway.

GENERAL RULES: The consumption of alcoholic beverages in the facility is forbidden until all racing activities have concluded for the day. ATV's, bicycles, motorized carts and motorcycles are permitted in certain areas provided they are used in a safe manner and operated ONLY by licensed drivers. Skateboards, skates, rollerblades, micro/mini racers and go-peds are NOT permitted. No person will be admitted into the raceway without the proper credentials. Absolutely NO bedding new brakes or testing of cars on infield roadways will be permitted. Violations will result in immediate ejection from the premises. This penalty will be enacted for all offenses, with zero tolerance. The raceway gates will not be opened until 5:00pm Friday.
