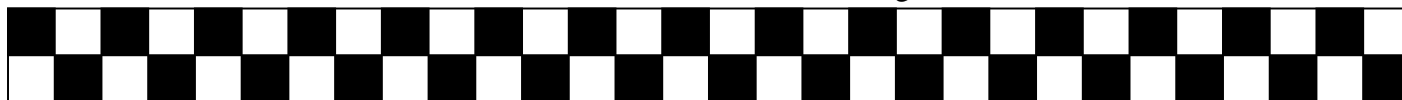

Details

Registration - Registration will be conducted during the hours indicated in the Schedule at the CFR Operations Building located on Earwood Blvd. outside the perimeter of the Track. If you are a Worker or a Guest, you are expected to register during the scheduled hours. If you have an emergency that prevents you from using these hours you may call **407-257-7285** or the Registration room at **863-655-6048**. Note that this is not a substitute for regular Registration and should not be used for the sake of convenience. Responsibilities permitting, we will try to help you when we can but please, no calls after 8:00 PM. Registration will be closed and no credentials will be available after 8:30 AM Saturday morning.

Credentials: The Official Credential for this Event will be the CFR Race Control, Hard Card, Photo ID. The new version of this Card does not expire. It can be updated at Registration. If you must obtain a new Hard Card it will take some time. Please plan your schedule accordingly. As usual, you must present your "current" SCCA Membership Card and Specialty License in order to receive the Validation Sticker. There are no exceptions to this rule. Don't ask.

TEST DAYS: Sebring International Raceway (SIR) no longer uses Volunteers to staff their Test Days conducted on Monday and Tuesday.

Camping: The CFR Campground will be available on a first come, first served basis. Use of the limited power & water hookups will be on the same basis. Unless you are sleeping in your vehicle, do not park it in the Campground.

Parking: Except for Official Vehicles, there are NO Parking Credentials available for this Event. You are expected to park in the area adjacent to the Campground. Shuttles will be provided for your use.

Worker Meetings: Flagging & Communications personnel will meet each day, one hour prior to Green Course times. These meetings will be held at the campground. Pit Marshals will meet at Pit Central, 8:00 AM Saturday Morning. If you plan to work earlier in the week, contact your Chief.

Meals: Lunches will be provided "on Station" Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. A light dinner will also be delivered Saturday Evening. A dinner buffet will be served on Friday in conjunction with the Social held at the CFR Operations Building. Bon Appetit' !

Event Day Parking: When the infield and paddock are judged to be full, incoming traffic will be diverted to parking in the field adjacent to the highway and spectators will be shuttled into the Track. Plan to arrive early.
